We are reaching out to you as a valued member of the Ken Caryl / Littleton business community about our campaign to raise money for the Neuroendocrine Cancer Awareness Network (NCAN).

This year the Dakota Ridge High School and Chatfield High School Volleyball programs are teaming up to fight NET cancer. This issue has touched our local volleyball community deeply. In 2019, Judy Antener, the mother of Berkley and Quincy, two former players (one a current Senior) for Dakota Ridge High School Volleyball, was diagnosed with Neuroendocrine Cancer. Judy had been misdiagnosed for several months, as this cancer is commonly mistaken for many other very common illnesses, and sadly passed away in July of 2020. Neuroendocrine Cancer is extremely rare, and is often misdiagnosed, so it is our goal to help the Antener family and NCAN raise awareness and money to help save more lives.

Our volleyball teams will be fundraising this Fall by co-hosting a "Think Zebra" volleyball game on October 19th, 2021. We will be selling custom designed tee shirts during the volleyball games (image above), as well as silent auction/raffle items to raise money. All proceeds from the night will go directly to NCAN.
